

RETEST INFORMATION

Opportunities for taking a written certification retest if the written test is failed can be made by contacting the CCET office at 607-587-4017. Test sites are located at Hudson Valley Community College, Erie Community College, SUNY Orange and SUNY Alfred. The fee is \$125 payable to the Research Foundation upon verification of a test date and site.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

In order to provide the highest level of quality for transportation facilities, most state agencies along with AASHTO, FHWA and NAPA have adopted quality assurance specifications. Part of this process includes using qualified personnel for sampling and testing. According to federal regulations “all sampling and testing data to be used in acceptance decision or the IA program will be executed by qualified sampling and testing personnel.” (Federal Regulation 23 CRF 637) HMA Density Inspector Certification Program is intended to provide qualification of personnel performing density testing on Hot Mix Asphalt in New York State. Certification is valid for five years and is based on attending the two day program and successfully passing the written examination.

Chapter 2 Density and Pavement Performance

Chapter 3 Determining the Density of HMA Pavements

Chapter 4 Controlling the Variables that Influence the Compaction of HMA

Chapter 5 NYS Density Testing Inspector Roles and Responsibilities

Chapter 6 Use of Density as a Quality Characteristic in NYS

WRITTEN EXAM INFORMATION

Participants are able to use their manual during the exam. Examinees must receive at least 70% per section and an 80% overall for the entire exam. Failing of the section or of the overall examination will require a written retest. The exam will be 100 multiple choice and true/false questions. Some questions may include calculations.

Chapter 4 - 20 questions
Chapter 5 - 30 questions
Chapter 6 - 25 questions
