SUBJECT	GRADE *	TEACHER COMMENTS
Roads	C-	Student continues to raid Dedicated Trust Fund for other purposes. Now, only 10 cents per dollar that goes into the Fund is actually spent on road repair or construction.
Bridges	C-	37% of the bridges in New York State are in substandard condition.
Safety	C+	Student ignored warning from his own independent advisory panel that without new investment, "the infrastructure will deteriorate, the economy will falter, jobs will be lost and the quality of life in New York State will suffer dramatically."
Congestion	D+	Student is constantly in a state of denial. He lacks effort and vision, as apparent by his most recent budget proposal that only funds three years of a five-year capital plan.
