Aerial lifts are extremely useful pieces of equipment and are commonly used by contractors and subcontractors of many different trades. But this equipment can be hazardous to both operators and employees working nearby unless proper precautions are taken by all employees while at work. If you work in aerial lifts or near them on the ground, you need to understand the hazards, the basic regulatory requirements, and the safety work practices that must be followed to prevent accidents and injuries. - **Towing** (including Coupler; Tow Vehicle & Hitch Information; Coupling & Uncoupling the Trailer; Coupling the Trailer to the Hitch; Uncoupling the Trailer from the Hitch; Rigging Safety Chains; Towing Guidelines; Pre-Tow Inspection)
- **Emergency Procedures** (including Incident Notification; Operator Unable to Control Machine; Platform or Boom Caught Overhead)
