Globally Harmonized System of Classification of Labeling of Chemical (GHS)

Mandatory training for the construction industry by December 1, 2013

Those taking this class may bring the training back to your firms as a "Train the Trainer"

OSHA is making changes to the Hazard Communication Standard which will align the US into conformity with the Globally Harmonized System of Classification of Labeling of Chemicals (GHS). The Standard scope and application requires employers to provide information to their employees about the hazardous chemicals to which they are exposed; by means of a hazard communication program, labels and other forms of warning, Safety Data Sheets, as well as information and training.

In addition, the training requirements for employees must include methods and observations that may be used to detect the presence or release of a hazardous chemical in the work area; cover the physical, health, simple asphyxiation, combustible dust, and pyrophoric gas hazards, as well as hazards not otherwise addressed; review measures employees can take to protect themselves from these hazards, and provide details of the hazard communication program developed by the employer. **Employers must train their employees regarding the new label elements and Safety Data Sheet format by December 1, 2013.** However, the chemical manufacturers, importers, distributors, and employers must be in compliance with modified provision of the standard no later than June 1, 2015.

Directions to AGC NYS Albany Safety Training Center

From North:

Take Rt. 87 (Northway) South to Exit 2E. Follow ramp around to Central Avenue (Rt. 5) East. * Get in the far right lane and turn right into Northway Mall. Continue right, past Staples (on right), and continue around to the back of the strip mall. Turn left behind mall. Turn right onto Railroad Avenue. Go one-half mile to #116. Park on either side of the building.

From South:

Take Thruway to Exit 24. After the toll, take Exit 1N for Rt. 87 North (the Northway).

Take Exit 2E, Wolf Road. * Get in the far right lane and turn right into Northway Mall.

Continue right, past Staples (on right), and continue around to the back of the strip mall. Turn left behind mall. Turn right onto Railroad Avenue. Go one-half mile to #116. Park on either side of the building.
