HOTEL INFORMATION

EUROPEAN MEAL PLAN - No meals are included in the room rate.

PAYMENT AND HOTEL CANCELLATION POLICIES - A credit card is required to confirm each reservation. Individual reservations must be cancelled **14 days prior to arrival**. Any cancellations made after 6pm (local hoteltime), 14 days before the scheduled arrival date will result in a penalty of one night's room charge plus any package add-ons. Guests that do not check in by midnight on the day of arrival will be responsible for the full amount of the reservation stay.
