## **HOTEL INFORMATION**

**EUROPEAN MEAL PLAN** - No meals are included in the room rate.

**SERVICE CHARGE** - Room rates are subject to an 8% NYS sales tax and a 5% occupancy tax.

**RESORT FEE** - There will be a 7% taxed Resort Fee/per day added to each room that entitles you to two complimentary bottles of water in your room daily, complimentary coffee daily, wireless internet in guest rooms and public areas, no charge for local and 800 calls, entrance into the Fitness Center, indoor/outdoor pools and waterfront, self or valet parking, Island and Golf Club shuttle.
